### SAMPLE TOUR ITINERARY

#### DAY 1 SYDNEY / KUALA LUMPUR

Board your Malaysia Airlines flights to Kuala Lumpur. On arrival and after clearing customs and immigration you will be met by our tour operator and transferred to your accommodation. Enjoy dinner at a nearby local Malaysian restaurant

#### DAY 2 KUALA LUMPUR

Morning orientation tour of Kuala Lumpur where you will be introduced to the humble beginning of the city to what it is today - a modern cosmopolitan city. Visit the National Monument, Sultan Abdul Samad Building - Independence Square, the Selangor Club & the King's Palace and enjoy a breathtaking view of the city from KL Tower before returning to your hotel

Return transfers for tour fixtures

#### DAY 3 KUALA LUMPUR

Morning at leisure for optional sightseeing and shopping

In the evening enjoy a traditional Malay buffet dinner with a colourful cultural show. After dinner, visit Chinatown - a busy and noisy bazaar where both locals and tourists alike can be found browsing through these street stalls and vendors selling clothes, leatherwear, watches and food.

#### DAY 4 KUALA LUMPUR

Return transfers for tour fixtures

#### DAY 5 KUALA LUMPUR / PENANG

Transfer by coach to Penang. En-route visit Bukit Merah Laketown Resort - Orang Utan Island.

Board a boat to the Orang Utan Island. The orang utans roam free on the island and visitors watch them from a 'cage-tunnel'. The island is a rehabilitation facility and provides a great opportunity to view orang utans outside a zoo environment. Cross over to Penang using the Penang Bridge, the fifth longest bridge in the world and check into your hotel. Dinner at local restaurant

#### DAY 6 PENANG

Return transfers for tour fixtures

In the afternoon enjoy a half day historic tour of Penang - the Pearl of the Orient and the oldest British settlement in Malaysia. Visits include the Khoo Kongsi (Dragon Mountain Hall) clan house with its ancient design constructed to capture the splendor of an Imperial palace, the historical Fort Cornwallis and the Thai temple of Wat Chayamangkalaram, which houses a 32 metres reclining Buddha.

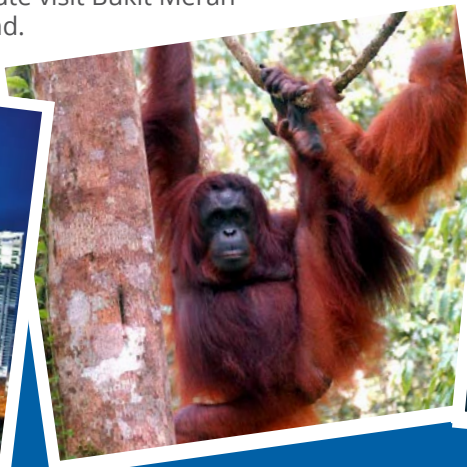
#### DAY 7 PENANG

Return transfers for tour fixtures

In the evening visit the night market along Ferringhi Beach. The stalls are lined along the road selling local souvenirs, clothes, and handicrafts. Try the local hawker fare at the food stalls

#### DAY 8 PENANG / KUALA LUMPUR / SYDNEY

Transfer to Penang Airport for your return flight to Sydney (via Kuala Lumpur)
