THE 10 TOURING COMMANDMENTS

1. Ascertain student/parent interest.
2. Obtain official approval from School Executive Committee.
3. Select a Tour Co-ordinator and Committee
4. Set up a Tour account.
5. Choose a destination that is suitable and attainable.
6. Prepare a budget and required fundraising activities.
7. Devise a student's savings scheme and obtain an initial non-refundable deposit.
8. Plan regular meetings which are compulsory for registered participants.
9. Ensure that all students participate in fundraising activities.
10. Choose a travel agent who specialises in school/sports touring.

These guidelines are the culmination of over 20 years of experience in tour organising and if followed, will give the venture a fair chance of success. It is the same as playing the game - **the laws are clearly defined and the best results are obtained by concerted team effort.**
